Theme: Christmas not Holiday

Scripture: Matthew 1:23 (HCSB) *“See, the virgin will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they will name Him Immanuel,” which is translated “God Is with us.”*

A Thought: A very well known and established television news pundit was asked what he thought about the Christmas - Holiday (terms) controversy. His reply was curt followed by a gracious addendum...”What controversy? Isn’t it the birth of the Prince of Peace? I’m Jewish and I don’t see a problem.” Every year during the Christmas season we read, hear and see television news stories with folks chattering and sometimes mindless blather on the said controversy. There are those in both camps who state...what is the big deal? To many it is a big deal. As Christians we must be mindful that especially in a western country we live in a pluralistic society. In my opinion that is a good thing. Nevertheless for the past two decades or so we have seen a trend with many of the Christian and Christmas traditions eking away and or at worst blurring their respective significance of our faith. Even though we live in a pluralistic society we should not be intimidated. Nothing but nothing in the world should break us away from our faith. It may sound arrogant but it is (our belief) a stated fact according to John 14:15-17 (NIV) *“If you love me, keep my commands. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever, the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.”* We know or should know why we celebrate Christmas (more later) and not be persuaded by pluralistic trends. Hence, the importance of knowing the truth...1 Corinthians 8:5-6 (HCSB) *“For even if there are so-called gods, whether in heaven or on earth--as there are many “gods” and many “lords”-- yet for us there is one God, the Father from whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and we through Him.”*
